WHAT IS AN EDUCATIONAL ASSESSMENT?

Educational Assessments involve
the measurement of knowledge and
skills to produce a picture of the
student's cognitive capacity, abilities,
learning style and learning preferences. An
Educational Assessment is required to identify
and diagnose learning disorders, learning
difficulties and intellectual giftedness, and can assist
in identifying learning strengths and weaknesses.

An Educational Assessment will:

- Identify the presence and type of deficit where one exists
- Provide recommendations to address the deficit, or educational adjustments to minimise the impact of the deficit
- Ensure your child's teacher and school are aware of your child's learning gaps or deficits
- Assist the school in developing an individualised learning plan for your child
- Support applications for additional funding (in the case of severe deficits or behavioural difficulties).
